Story

Loxton North is home to a small, beautiful Temple Bruer vineyard with 50-year-old shiraz and grenache vines. Acquired in 2011, the vines were reworked and certified organic. In 2015, similar investment and treatment was undergone for a vineyard with sensational mataro vines in Moorook, overlooking Wachtels Lagoon.

Both vineyards have been lovingly and fully re-established over the last few years and are now thriving and producing concentrated, balanced fruit for this charming blend.
