Shiraz, the staple of Australian wine and a favourite of Temple Bruer.

We source the best grapes from our vineyards across South Australia's brilliant wine regions, each grape specifically chosen to elevate another.

Grapes were harvested from vines of varying ages, up to 40 years old, throughout the duration of the 2021 Vintage. Picking started early in Moorook, Riverland in mid-February, moving through Eden Valley, then Currency Creek, and concluded with Langhorne Creek two months later, in mid-April.

Deep Purple

Nose

Mulberry, blackberry, bramble, and rhubarb. Black plum with notes of liquorice, star anise, and black pepper. Slight lifted notes of raspberry and dark cherry.

Full bodied with savoury plum and spice. Low-medium acid and tannins that are fine and mouth coating.
