Our ever-evolving Pinot Noir is enchantingly captivating. This delightful drop easily lends itself to an early drinking style, bursting with vibrant fresh fruit notes and a complex palate that intrigues from the first sip.

Most of our 2023 Pinot Noir hails from our Eden Valley estate, a picturesque landscape adorned with rolling hills, majestic ancient gums, and a cornucopia of native birds. Diverse soils enrich our grapes with complexity and depth, a distinctive trait that shines through in every glass.

Vintage 2023 saw a wet spring, leading to delayed ripening and varied picking times. The cool conditions and prolonged fermentation enriched the wine's fresh fruit character, boasting an elegant bouquet graced with soft, lingering tannins.
