Story

Shiraz, the staple of Australian wine and a favourite of Temple Bruer.

We source the best grapes from our vineyards across South Australia's brilliant wine regions. In 2022, we saw high-quality fruit and low to moderate yields with excellent natural acidity from an overall cool vintage with extended ripening periods. Perhaps one of the longest vintages we have experienced, harvesting began at the warmer sites in the Riverland in mid-February and concluded in the cooler sites of Currency Creek and Langhorne creek in March and April.
